## 2024 CALIFORNIA CONFERENCE FOR WOMEN DRAWS BIG NAMES

## Brené Brown, Former Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern, Jennifer Siebel Newsom, and More to Headline Feb. 29th Event

**SANTA CLARA, Jan. 26, 2024 –** The fourth annual California Conference for Women will serve up a fresh look at women and the workplace with help from some of the biggest names in California and the world.

Addressing topics ranging from leadership to entrepreneurship and artificial intelligence, keynote speakers will include:

Approximately 4,620 women are expected to attend the conference, which will be held on Thursday, February 29, at the Santa Clara Convention Center. Several dozen top leadership, career advancement, and personal development experts will also lead breakout sessions.
